Important information for the duration of your stay

PLEASE NOTE: Some of the following information has been put together from ideas presented to us by our visitors & by the Health and Safety Executive.

For emergencies **DIAL 999 FREEPHONE** at the phone box at the farm. For disturbances on our park at night please come to the farm house or ring us on 015396 25239/25537 at the phone box (20p) or on your mobile phone.

You may arrive 8am to 10pm Leaving time at your own leisure.
Whenever possible please pay your site fees on arrival or on the same day. For extra days please register before **11 am each morning**.

Showers may fluctuate in temperature due to demand on services please start at lower settings and work up.

Danger – do not tamper with electric hook-up boxes or the caravan park lights.
There is a 10amp maximum 2kw per hook-up. Please do not exceed this with household domestic appliances.
Owners to pay electrical engineer call out if hook-up owners are not at fault.

All water on the site is mains.

Also up at the farm we have a shop selling dairy produce, barbeque meat, hot pies, camping equipment and midge repellent. Also an information point, ladies and gents shower blocks, washing up and laundry area and vending refreshment area.
Freeze for ice packs, ice cubes, ice cream etc.
Church bells **ringing**, cows **mooring** and sheep **baaing** - Earplugs are also available!

Please **DO NOT DRIVE** your cars to the toilet blocks.

If stuck or sliding with your vehicles please come for help to avoid damaging the field surface.

For safety reasons there is a **5mph** speed limit on the park fields.

STRICTLY VERY QUIET MUSIC ONLY PLEASE AT ALL TIMES

**** THE VERY STRICT RULE ON OUR PARK IS NO NOISE OR BARBEQUES AFTER 11.30PM OR VISITORS FROM THE VILLAGE OR OTHER CAMPSITES ****

Anyone reported breaking this rule after **11.30pm** will be asked to leave the park immediately. These rules ensure fellow campers and nearby residents are not disturbed.

No open fires, please use stands provided for disposable barbeques.

DANGER Dry stone walls please **DO NOT** climb on them or over them. Also **Stones** not to be removed from the walls.

Please put cans, glass bottles, plastic bottles and newspapers into labelled bins provided

No dog walking on the park fields, or the surrounding fields.

Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times – accidental fouling must be removed immediately.

Please keep dogs quiet.

We recommend for the sake of all countryside lovers you remove **dog dirt** from all paths and highways.

* **The farmers** of the dale request that visitors and dogs please keep to the footpaths, this ensures crops and stock are protected. Beware cows with calves could chase dogs.

- Leave all gates as found
- Keep dogs under close control
- Keep to public paths across farmland

- Protect wildlife, plants and trees
- Take special care on country roads
- Make no unnecessary noise
