PLEASE NOTE: Some of the following information has been put together from ideas presented to us by our visitors & the Health and Safety Executive.

For emergencies **DIAL 999 FREE PHONE** at the phone box at the farm. For disturbances on our park in the night please come to the farm house or ring us on **01539 625953** at the phone box (20p) or on your mobile phone.

Please pay your site fees on arrival or on the same day. For extra days please register between **10 am and 11 am each morning.**

You may arrive 9am to 8pm Leaving time off the park at your own leisure.

For safety reasons there is a **5mph** speed limit on the park.

Please come up to the farm toilet blocks when the low block is crowded.

If you are stuck or sliding with your vehicles please come for help immediately to avoid damaging the field surface.

Please **DO NOT DRIVE** your cars to the toilet blocks.

You are requested to keep all noise, T.V and music VERY LOW throughout the day and night.

Sorry no football, children riding bikes or excessive noise at anytime on the park fields

The games area is through the stile in the wall at the bottom corner of the site through the trees. Also quietness would be appreciated till 10.00am mornings.

THE VERY STRICT RULE ON OUR PARK IS NO NOISE, T.V, MUSIC OR BARBEQUES AFTER 11.30PM OR VISITORS FROM THE VILLAGE OR OTHER CAMPSITES. This ensures fellow campers and nearby residents are not disturbed. Anyone reported or heard by the security guard after 11.30pm will be asked to LEAVE the park **IMMEDIATELY.**

All water on the site is mains.

Set the shower to the recommended setting, put the money in the meter, then wait the shower will then come up to temperature do not adjust.

Danger – do not tamper with electric hookup boxes or the caravan park lights. There is a 10amp maximum 2kw per hookup. Please do not exceed this.

No household domestic appliances to be used.

Owners to pay electrical engineer call out if hook-up owners are not at fault.

Up at the farm we have a dairy shop selling most produce, barbeque meats, hot pies, ice cream, ice cubes, freezer for ice packs, camping equipment and midge repellent.

Information point, ladies and gents shower blocks, washing up and laundry area, vending refreshment area.

A book stall for the Air Ambulance charity £1 donation per book, we are always glad to receive your unwanted books

Church bells **ringing**, cows **mooring** and sheep **baaing** - Earplugs are also available!

Please make arrangements for day visitors with cars at the farm reception.

No open fires, please use stands or red bricks provided for disposable barbeques or the plastic honeycomb under grass will melt

DANGER Dry stone walls please **DO NOT** climb on them or over them. Also **Stones** not to be removed from the walls.

★ **Recycling refuse** labelled bins provided.
We try to keep the site free of litter.

Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times – accidental fouling must be removed immediately.

No dog walking on the park fields or the surrounding fields' day or night.

Please keep dogs quiet.

We recommend for the sake of all countryside lovers you remove **dog dirt** from all paths and highways.

★ **The farmers** of the dale request that visitors and dogs please keep to the footpaths, this ensures crops and stock are protected. Beware cows with calves they could chase people and dogs.
